Old School!

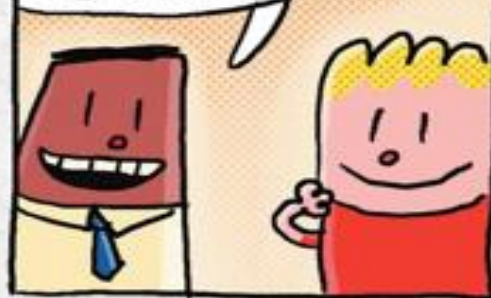
And Look how bad you used to SPELL!!!

Let's make a new comic Book.



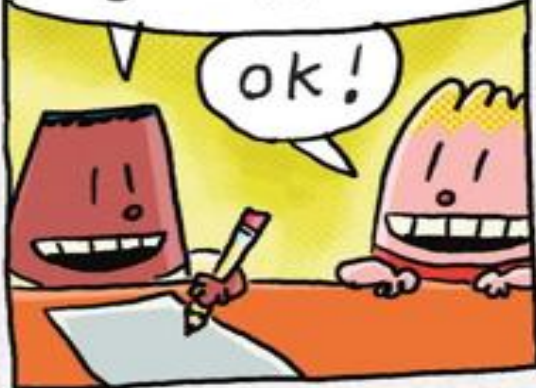
About Captain Underpants?

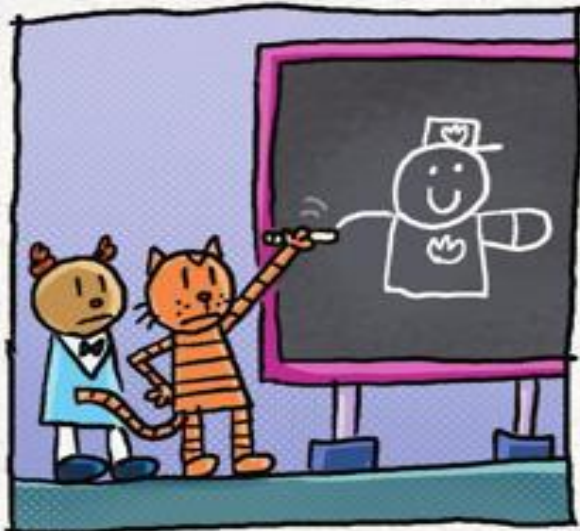

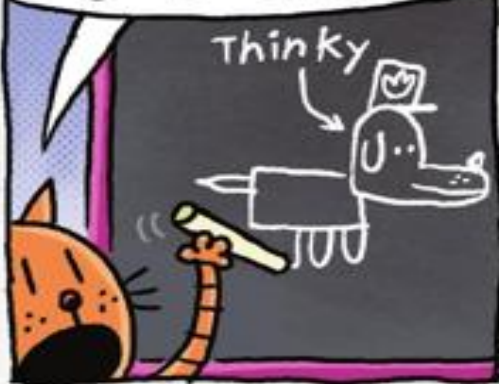

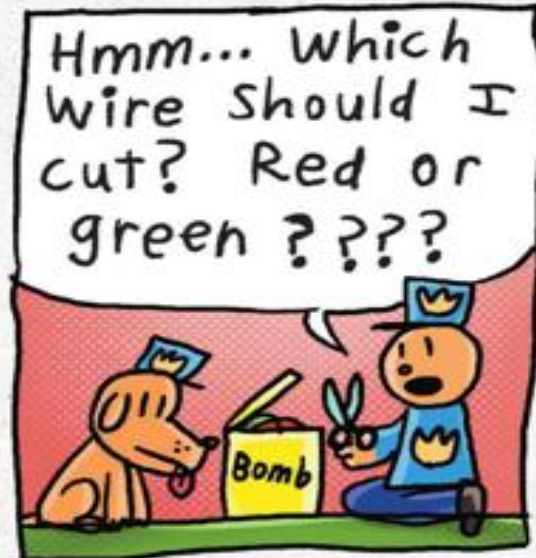
